

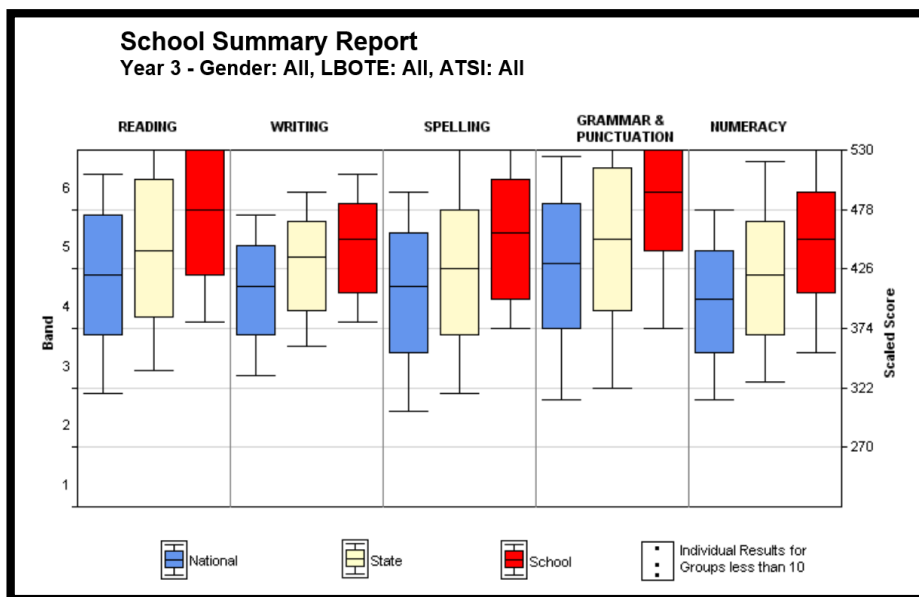

NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual national assessment for all students in Years 3, 5, 7, and 9. All students in these year levels are expected to participate in tests in reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

NAPLAN tests are one aspect of each school's assessment and reporting process, and do not replace the extensive, ongoing assessments made by teachers about each student's performance. The tests provide parents and schools with an understanding of how individual students, as well as whole cohorts of students are performing at the time of the tests as well as the progress and development of entire cohorts of students.
