# 2026 FEE SCHEDULE

Hillcrest Christian College values the timely payment of school fees. To ensure consistency and ease of administration, all families are required to participate in a Direct Debit arrangement, with monthly payments as the default option. Families who choose to pay fees upfront—either annually or bi-annually—are exempt from the Direct Debit requirement.

## EARLY PAYMENT DISCOUNT

**Bi-Annual:** 2% discount if **all** fees are paid by 16th of February and 24th of July.

**Annual:** 3% discount if **all** fees are paid by 16th of February.

*(Discounts are only applicable to tuition fees and will not be granted if the account is in arrears or if the payment is made after the due date)*

## SIBLING DISCOUNT

(NOT including 3YO and 4YO ELC)

Highest year level is classified as 1st child and is applicable on the tuition fee only.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Sibling** – 20% **3<sup>rd</sup> Sibling** – 50%

**4<sup>th</sup> Sibling** – 75% **5<sup>th</sup> Sibling** -100%

## RESOURCE LEVY

This compulsory levy includes camps (Year 2 - 12), classroom materials and digital learning resources.

This will be billed to your annual school fee account.

## ADDITIONAL LEVIES

Additional levies may apply based on your child's subject selections and participation in extracurricular activities. These charges will be invoiced separately as applicable and must be paid before commencement.

*\*Replacements of Badges & Lost Library books will be billed to your additional levy account.*
